2025 NSW Open and Junior Championships

The 2025 NSW Open Championships saw our 6 open athletes in action. Bryce Nolan created WAC history when he successfully defended his Open Discus title for the third time (2022, 2024 & 2025). He was still 18 years old when he first won the title 4 years ago. Bryce had a surprise for us all when he also won the Open Shot Put with a new P.B. with the massive 7.4kg wieighted shot. Rashid Kabba finished his NSW season with a long awaited comeback performance winning his first ever Open medal, a well deserved Bronze medal. Malikye Kessie was predicted to win the NSW to win the 100m NSW title. He was clearly leading at the 60m mark when a tightened hamstring ended that expectation. He was the reigning NSW Open 60m Champion, but unfortunately in the 100m

final he was forced to slow down and prevent a serious injury.

The 2025 NSW Junior Championships, under the new amalgamation of NSWLAA and ANSW, allowed U14-U16 athletes the option of competing with either their senior or Little A's club. Those who competed for their Little A's club are listed separately below.

Nevertheless all of our junior athletes performed brilliantly. **Kunal Menon** was probably the most outstanding. In 2024 he won the U20 bronze, however this time he won the Gold he in a high quality field which included the reigning National U20 Champion. Kunal ran well under the current

World U20 qualifying standard into a slight headwind; an absolutely powerful performance which was unexpected by most onlookers. **Zaynab Darwiche** confidently won the silver medal in the U18 400m smashing a 23 year old WAC record by half a second. **Beau Sinclair** performed extremley well finishing closely behind the current Australian All Schools Champion for a silver medal just 0.01 second off his P.B. **Amelia Darek** jumped to new heights in the U17 pole vault in winning her NSW title for the 4th consecutive year.
